GAME TIMES

Four (4) 8 minute quarters – 5 minute warm-up/halftime – 2 minute overtime periods.

FORMAT OF TOURNAMENT

A pool play (round robin style play) system will be used. In the pool play system; a cap of 15 points for tiebreaker will be used if needed to break three way ties. Teams must play all scheduled games or penalties will be applied.

POOL PLAY

1. In any situation where two (2) teams are tied, head-to-head competition between the teams will determine the winner.
2. If more than two (2) teams tie, a point differential tiebreaker will be applied. The point differentials of the teams involved in the tie are totaled. Teams are then ranked according to the sum of the point differential - with the highest number placing first, the second highest placing second. (The maximum that you can beat a team and still gain an advantage is 15 points.)
3. If more than two (2) teams are still tied after the application of the formula, the point differentials of the teams not involved in the tie are added, and the results recalculated.
4. If teams are still tied a COIN FLIP will be used to determine who will advance out of pool. (Odd coin out)
5. The score of all forfeits shall be 15-0.

RULES

Competition will follow the rules and regulations as specified in the AAU Girls Basketball Handbook and the NCAA Rule Book. A 30-second shot clock will be used. Teams must have both **LIGHT JERSEYS AND DARK JERSEYS!**

During pool play, team listed **first** is HOME TEAM; during bracket play team listed on **top** is home team. Home team wears **LIGHT**.

Due to the number of teams participating in this event a guaranteed minimum of 5 minutes will be used for warm-up, and 5 minutes will be used at halftime.

PLAYER FOUL RULE

A player will be disqualified on her 6th personal foul in the 9th grade, 10th grade, 11th grade.

TIMEOUTS

Three full (75 second) timeouts and two 30 second timeouts. Only two full timeouts, and one 30 second timeout will carry over to the second half. If one full and one 30 second timeout are not used in the first half they will be forfeited. Teams will be awarded one 30 second timeout in each overtime period, plus any unused timeouts remaining from the second half.

BENCH DECORUM

1. Uniforms: Players' jerseys must have numbers on both the front and back. Numbers can be 00-99. Minimum size of numbers shall be 2" on the front and 4" on the back. Teams competing in showcase tournament must have light and dark jerseys.

BENCH PERSONNEL

A team may have on its bench only the eligible persons listed on its official roster, including up to four (4) non-players (coaches, ball boy, scorekeeper, etc.). Only eligible players may wear uniforms on the bench. Rostered athletes not dressing for a contest must meet dress code or wear their uniform.

Violation of this Rule shall result in the assessment of a 2-shot technical foul for each violation. Thereafter, the offending team shall have one minute to correct the violation. Any bench personnel not able to comply with this rule will not be allowed to sit on the bench and must move to spectator seating.

- At least one-person age 18 or older must be on the bench at all times.
- All Non-Athletes must be wearing the wristband provided at registration. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

PROTESTS

1. The National Girls Basketball Eligibility Committee shall handle all protests at Nationals.
2. For National Championship play, any eligibility protest that is turned in the first day of competition by 6 p.m. will be reviewed by the eligibility committee, and a decision will be made prior to bracket play. Any eligibility protest that comes after 6:00 pm of the first day of competition will be reviewed at the Eligibility Committee's discretion. All non-eligibility protests will be reviewed by the Eligibility Committee at their discretion.
3. A fee of \$100.00 cash (refunded if protest is upheld) must accompany all protests. Protests must come from a non-athlete member listed on the official online roster for the event. The written protest must be submitted to the National Commissioner-in-Charge. All decisions of the Eligibility Committee shall be final.

RUNNING CLOCK RULE

If there is a 30 point lead at any point in the 4th quarter, the clock will not stop until the score is within 15 points.
